## *Statement of Faith*

- The Scriptures of the Old and New Testament are the only unfailing and inspired Word of God, without error or fault in all its teaching and the supreme authority in all matters to which it speaks.
- God reveals himself as the loving and true God, Creator of all things, perfect in all His ways and eternally exists as a trinity of persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- Jesus Christ is the only Mediator between God and humankind. He is fully God and fully man and eternally God's Son. He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, shed his blood and died on the cross to pay the debt for our sins, bodily rose from the dead, and ascended to the right hand of the Father.
- The Holy Spirit by God's grace and for His glory through the proclamation of the gospel renews our hearts, persuades us to repent and confess Jesus Christ is Lord for the forgiveness of sin, lives in us as a seal and guarantee of our salvation, enables us to do the good works God has prepared for us and to live a godly life.
- Humankind was created in the image of God to have a relationship with Him. Yet, through disobedience, ignorance and inherited sinfulness, human beings are alienated from God by nature and by choice and therefore deserving of His wrath. Only through God's saving work in Jesus Christ can any human be rescued, reconciled and restored to a relationship with God.
- The Church is comprised of sinful men and women who have been transformed into the purified and unified body of Christ. The church includes all who have the Holy Spirit having been justified by God's grace through faith in Christ alone. The church is manifested through local communities of faith who gather to worship the One True God, understand and apply the Bible, celebrate Christ through communion (also called the Lord's Supper) and baptism, and live out God's gospel mission in word and in action.
- The Kingdom of God will be established when Jesus Christ returns to raise the dead, judge all humankind and finally establish His glorious reign. Those who have not received God's grace through Jesus Christ's sacrifice will be eternally separated from God's presence, and those who have been made righteous by the grace of God through Jesus Christ's sacrifice and regeneration of the Holy Spirit will live with God forever as He reigns over his perfect and eternal Kingdom.
