Kalam, Thomist, Leibnizian


the universe had to have a cause outside of itself

- 1. universe had a beginning; it is not eternal
- 2. everything has a cause; everything owes its existence to something else
- 3. why is there anything at all, rather than nothing

For what can be known about God is *plain* to them, because God has shown it to them. For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been *clearly perceived*, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. Romans 1:19-20




Conclusion: there must be a Transcendent Ordering Force



moral arguments

Relativism

ethical values vary based upon the circumstances

what may be considered right or wrong for one person may be totally different for another person

is that absolutely true and who made it this way?



moral arguments

Conventionalism

there are right and wrong ethical norms, but those are based upon the conventions of a culture or society and can be different from another

Egoism

Ethical Subjectivism

ethical norms are personal

what is true for you is true for you and what is true for me is true for me...

who are you to judge?
