





Religious Pluralism

the belief that every religion is true and has provided a valid pathway to God

Religious Relativism

the claim that there is no objective truth in any religion; each is simply true to the one who believes in it

Religious Exclusivism

the claim that only one way is true and all others are false

charges:


intolerance (pluralists are very intolerant of exclusivists)

problems:




if the claim of both-and is true, versus either-or, then we can have square circles or one-way streets that go both ways


Hindu pantheism is contrary to Christian theism: they are mutually exclusive


Islam denies/Christianity proclaims: Jesus' death & resurrection. These both cannot be true




















Exclusivity

Sample statements:


The easiest thing to do is just give in...


"Oh, I'm not saying that Jesus is the ONLY way."




Jesus made it exclusive

(Matthew 11:27)




Jesus made it exclusive
