Some countries require vaccinations in order to obtain a visa for entrance in to the country. Southeast does not cover the cost of the vaccinations because they are often good for 10 years and can be used for future trips individuals may take.

We do understand the costs can feel prohibitive, so we want to provide team members with a variety of locations where they can get vaccinations. Some locations may require a fee to see the Doctor and additional fees for the vaccinations. Others may strictly charge for the vaccines.

Please do your research to determine the location and costs that are the best fit.

Helpful Hint: Sometimes your insurance will allow a telehealth call to obtain a prescription for an anti-malarial. Be sure to contact your provider to determine if this service is offered as it may save money.
