



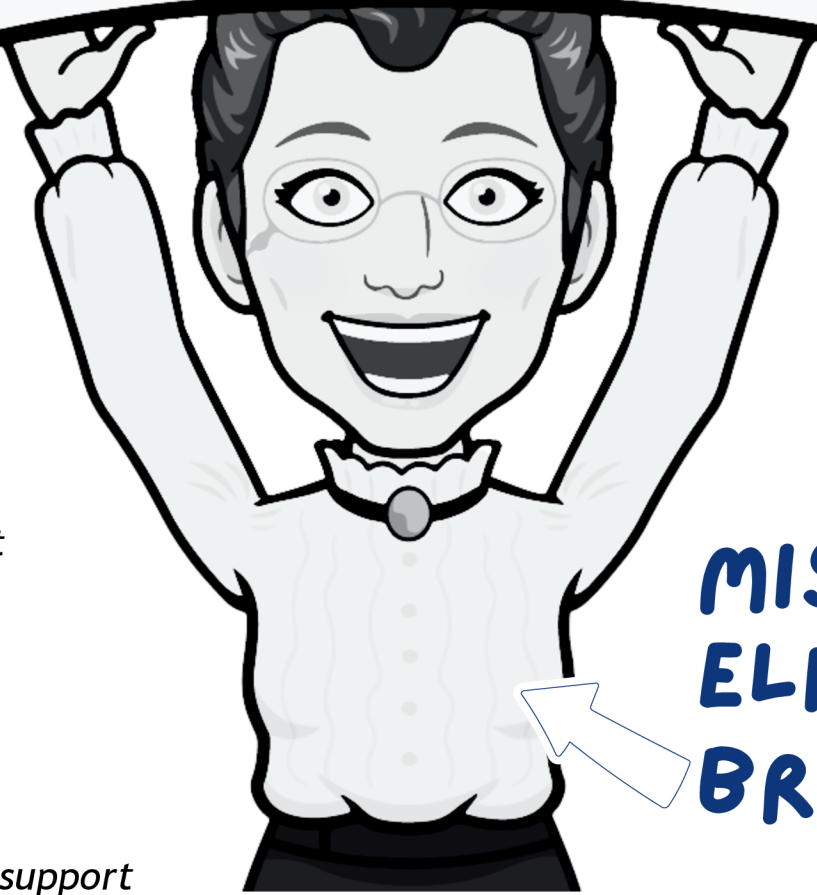

DOES SHE HAVE TO DO WITH MISSIONS IN KENTUCKY?



I thought you might ask that! I was actually born in Virginia in 1851. We moved to South Carolina where my father took a job as seminary professor. (A seminary is a school for pastors, missionaries, and other church leaders.) When I was 26, I moved with my family to Louisville, Kentucky. My father became a seminary professor at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He later became the seminary president.

I was involved in something called missionary societies. These societies, or groups, prayed for missions and collected special offerings to support missions. During that time, women who attended seminary classes did not have a place to stay on campus. I helped establish the WMU (Woman's Missionary Union) Training School for women.

In 1913, I led Kentucky WMU to take an offering for missions in Kentucky. In 1975, Kentucky WMU named the offering after me and called it the "Eliza Broadus Offering for State Missions." This offering is taken each September to help missionaries in Kentucky share the Good News of Jesus' love.

I don't think of myself as a super hero, but just for fun, follow me as I fly around Kentucky. We'll learn how KY-MSK Missionaries are sharing the Good News of Jesus all over Kentucky!

We'll start in Louisville, KY where the Kentucky WMU and Kentucky Baptist Convention are located!

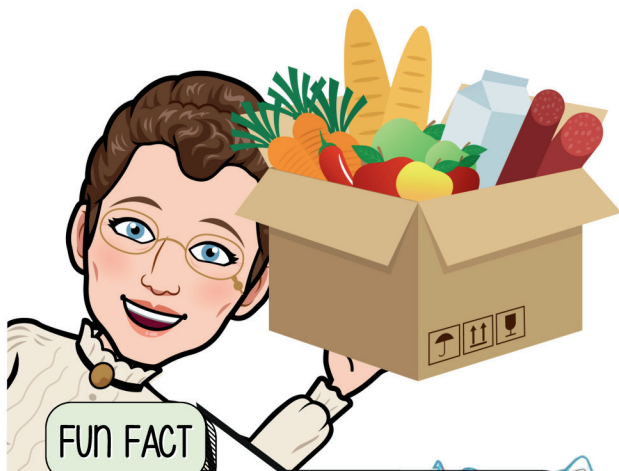

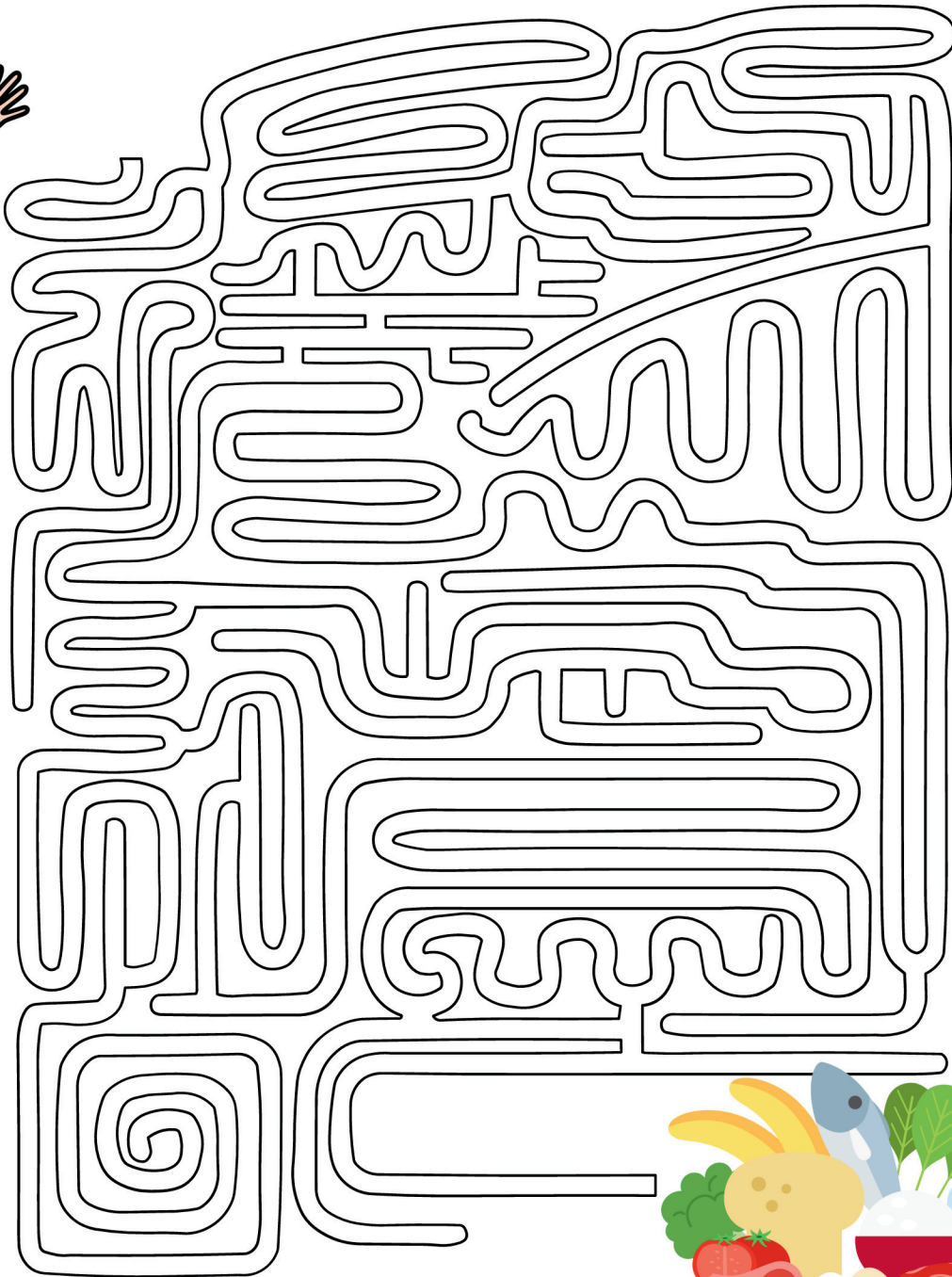

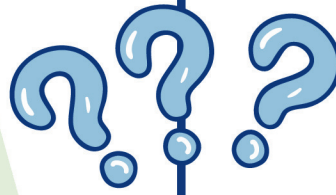

Now let's head east to another big city in Central Kentucky. You'll find lots of horse farms here and even the Kentucky Horse Park!

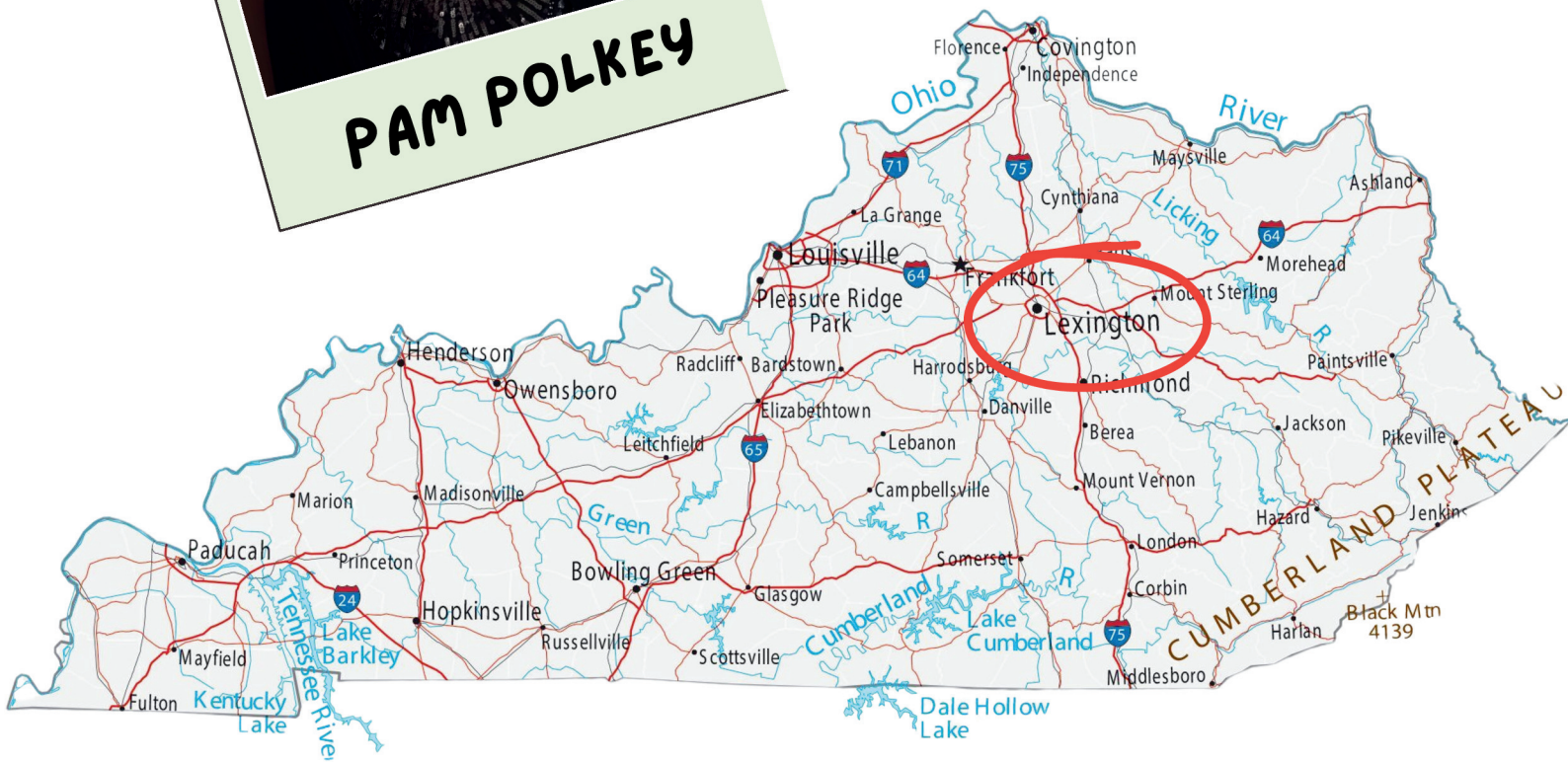

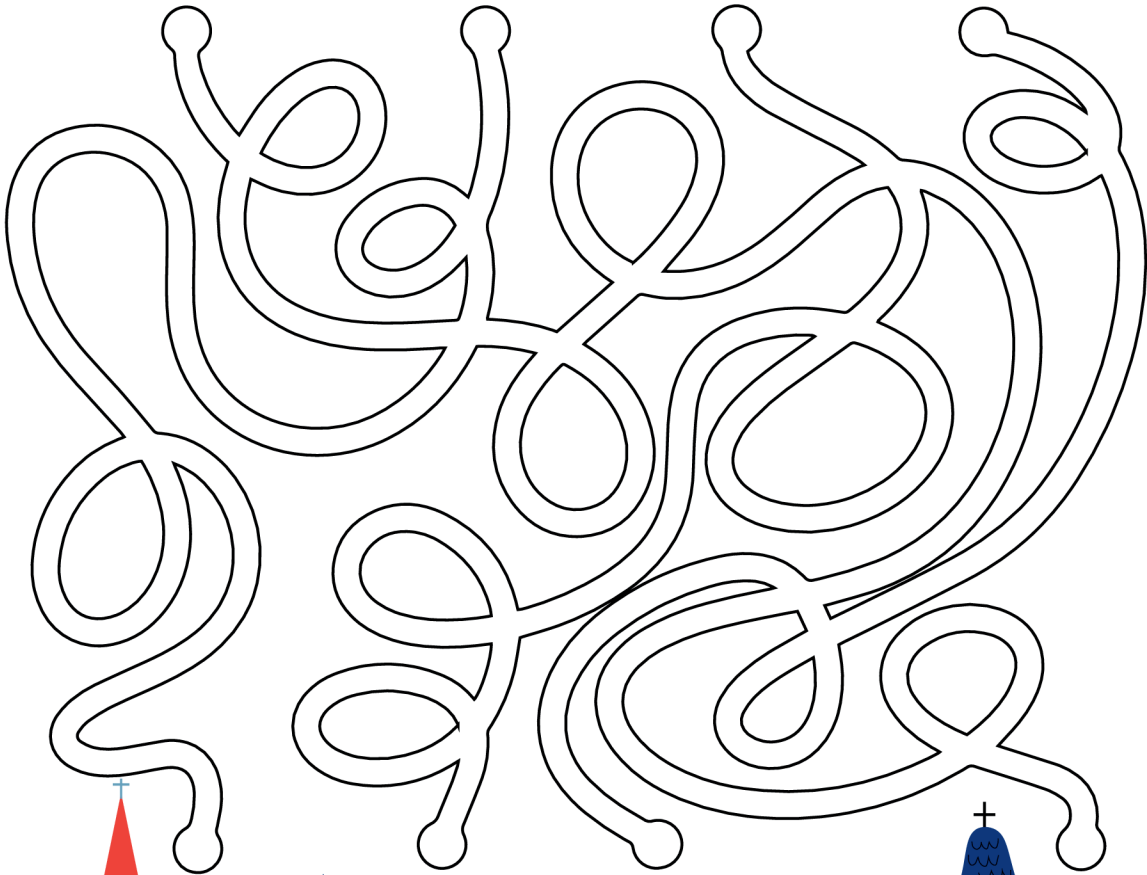

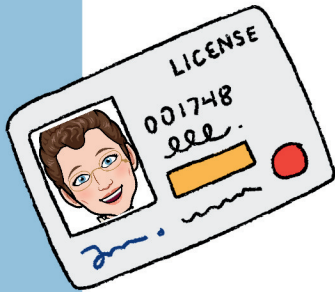
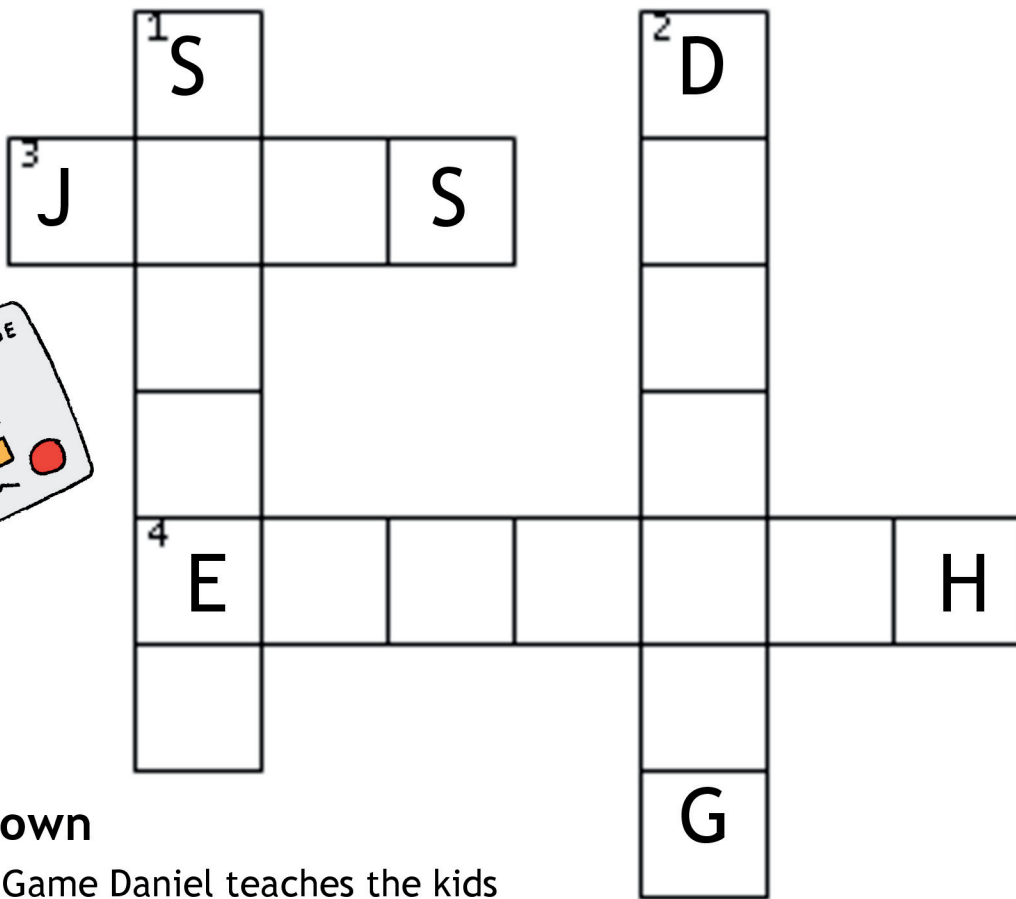
Did you know that Bowling Green is home to many refugees from around the world?

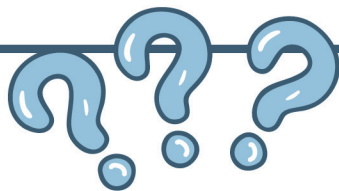
