Special Ministries Grants awarded in 2023 | \$113,500

The Eliza Broadus Offering® provides monetary support for our Kentucky Baptist Special Ministries affiliated with at least one of the following (1) Kentucky Baptist Convention, (2) local Baptist Association affiliated with the KBC, or (3) a KBC affiliated church. Grants are used for literature, Bibles, tracts, and other supplies for ministry/evangelism beyond the in-fellowship work of local churches.

Through an application process, 71 special ministries were awarded \$113,500.

KBC EBO® Allocations for 2023 | \$885,000 (Approved)

The Eliza Broadus Offering® provides monetary support for Kentucky Baptist convention (KBC) teams, agencies, and institutions that are specifically focused above or whose assignments relate to missions education and support in Kentucky. KBC receives their disbursement over a 12-month span. When the offering is not met, their last disbursement is adjusted.

In 2023, the KBC was received a total of \$871,190.85.

Kentucky WMU CP ALLOCATION | \$538,461.00

KBC sends the percentage of CP (2.4255% for KY WMU) monthly. Each month is based on the % of budget CP that has been reached. If KBC goes above budget (receipts), then the monthly allocation will be for the 1/12-budget-amount. At the end of the year, if CP has gone over budget, KY WMU receives their % of the overage.

In 2023, Kentucky WMU received a total of \$534,665.41.
